Category Descriptions

- Adult Day Programs** - provides supports and assistance that link people to their community (volunteering, exploring hobbies, making friends).
- Family Support Services/ Training** - family-directed, system of comprehensive services, designed and developed to enhance a family's ability to provide in-home care to their family members with a developmental disability.
- Health/Clinic** organizations that offer a variety of medical services and therapies.

- Early Intervention/School Age** - variety of therapies including Special Education for Children birth to 3 (EI) or Students 3 to 21 (school age).
- Recreation** - physical, social and creative opportunities to enrich life.
- Residential/Housing** - supports and services in your home and/or various housing alternatives.
- Respite** - short-term, temporary care so family members can take a break.

- Service Coordination** - assist persons with developmental disabilities in gaining access to necessary services and supports appropriate to the needs of the individual.
- Transportation** - a specific program for as-needed transportation to various locations.
- Vocational/Employment** - A service that provides competitive work in integrated settings and career development.

- **Recreation**- physical, social and creative opportunities to enrich life.
- **Residential/Housing**- supports and services in your home and/or various housing alternatives.
- **Respite**- short-term, temporary care so family members can take a break.
- **Service Coordination**- assist persons with developmental disabilities in gaining access to necessary services and supports appropriate to the needs of the individual.
- **Transportation**- a specific program for as-needed transportation to various locations.
- **Vocational/Employment**- A service that provides competitive work in integrated settings and career development.

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
