Thank you very much for your comment submitted to the Department of Health (DOH) for the public comment period on the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Final Rule Statewide Transition Plan. DOH forwarded your comments to OPWDD.

We appreciate your comments and your support of the OPWDD request for a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) in relation to the community integration and employment. The CAP request is pending review by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and we will share more information as it becomes available. Our impetus to request the CAP is based on the need to address the significant challenges our system faces.
